Watchman campground à Zion

Description:

Watchman campground is off line for reservations until further notice, please check back for updates.

Watchman Campground is one of two campgrounds located in the Main Canyon area of Zion National Park. It is an ideal location from which to base your stay in Zion. The campground is a short walk from the park's main Visitor Center. It is adjacent to the river for cooling off in the summer heat. It is also just a five minute walk to three of the park's hiking trails, including the park's only bicycle trail and only park trail on which leashed pets are allowed.

Generators are not permitted in Watchman Campground; however, 95 of the campground's 164 family campsites have electrical hookups. If you have a need for power during your camping stay, reserve a Standard Electric campsite. The remaining 69 family campsites are designated as Tent Only campsites. No RVs of any kind, including pop-ups, cabovers, and conversion vans, are allowed in the Tent Only campsites. The Virgin River flows around the edge of the campground; there are 16 campsites along the river. If you would like to camp along the river, reserve a Riverside Electric campsite.

Group camping is also available at Watchman Campground. There are seven group sites that can accommodate groups varying in size from 9 to 50 people. Tents are the only type of camping equipment allowed in the Group Sites.

South Campground is located 1/2 mile from Watchman Campground. It is open from March through October and has 127 campsites that are available on a first come first served basis.

From approximately April through October, a mandatory shuttle system operates on the Zion Canyon Scenic Drive. The free shuttle ride begins at the Visitor Center and stops at scenic viewpoints and trailheads in Zion Canyon. There is also a free shuttle that operates in the town of Springdale, which is immediately adjacent to the park. In Springdale, visitors can find a variety of restaurants, art galleries, and shops, in addition to small markets, pay showers, stores with firewood, and a medical clinic.

Watchman Campground is open year round. Reservations are accepted for camping from late March through October. Campsites are available on a first come first served basis during the off season.

Alerts and Important Information

Vehicles 7'10" in width or 11'4" in height or larger are required to have an escort through the Zion Mt. Carmel Tunnel located between the East Entrance and Zion Canyon. Escort permits are available at the park entrances for a fee of \$15.00. During summer months, escorts are available from 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. During winter months, escorts are available by appointment only between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

Single or combined vehicles (i.e. a motohome with a tow car attached or a vehicle towing a trailer, 5th wheel, or boat) over 50 feet long are prohibited from travelling through the park between the East Entrance and the campground. If your total length is greater than 50 feet, you must use an alternate route to arrive at Watchman Campground from U.S. 89.

Entrance into park is \$25 per private vehicle for seven days.

Gathering of firewood is prohibited.

Pets are allowed but must be leashed at all times and cleaned up after.

Late Arrivals:

You must call the campground if you will arrive more than 24 hours after the start of your reservation. If you do not call the campground to inform of your late arrival by 11:00 a.m. MT the day after your arrival date, your reservation will be processed as a no show, resulting in a \$20.00 no show fee plus you will be charged for your first night's camping fee. Call Watchman Campground at (435) 772-3837.

Family campsites at Watchman Campground are available on a walk up basis at the campground through the night of March 17, 2008. The campground will be closed to all camping on March 18 and March 19. On March 20, Watchman Campground (including group campsites) will reopen with the reservation system in place for the rest of the summer season.

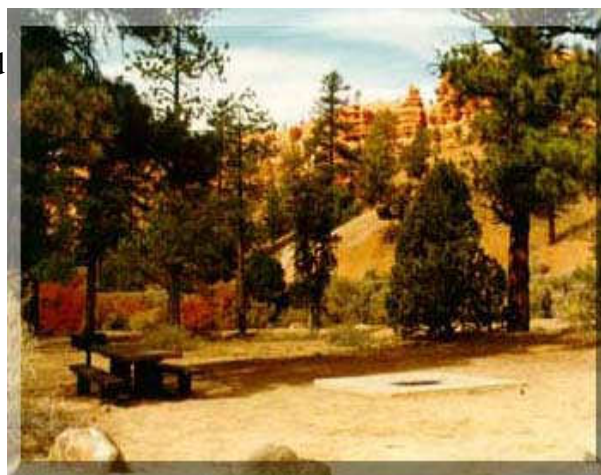

[Red Canyon campground](#)

Red Canyon Campground is situated in ponderosa pine, in Red Canyon, on Scenic Byway Utah State Highway 12. It is surrounded by Pink Claron Limestone formations similar to those found in Bryce Canyon National Park. The area around the campground has an extensive trail system for hiking, mountain biking, horses, and some ATV use. Check with the District Office for restrictions on individual trails. The campground has shower facilities, new flush restrooms, some new fire rings and grills, and paved sidewalks in some areas to provide improved access for people with disabilities. ATV riding is not allowed in Red Canyon Campground.

Camp sites are available on a first-come first-served basis, no reservation required. The Day Use Area can be reserved at the Powell Ranger District office, telephone number 435-676-9300.

[Fruita Campground](#)

The [Fruita](#) Campground is often described as an oasis within the desert. Surrounded by historic [orchards](#), this developed campground has 70 RV/tent sites, each with a picnic table and grill, but no hook-ups. An RV dump station is located near the entrance to Loop A. Heated restrooms are available. The nightly fee is \$10.00. Open year-round, the Fruita Campground is the only developed campground in Capitol Reef National Park and as a result usually fills by early to mid-afternoon during the visitor season. Although we do not take reservations for the campground, we do for the one [group campsite](#). Check with the Visitor Center for more information. [Fruita Campground](#) is located one mile south of the visitor center on the Scenic drive (or 1.3 miles south off State road 24 - 11 miles east of Torrey). It is opened year round and is the only developed campground in the park offering restrooms, water, and a dump station. During the summer, amphitheater presentations are offered nightly. Up to eight people may stay at a campsite. Campers may stay for a total of 14 days each year. Wood collection is not permitted in the park. The dump station is currently closed.

[Devils Garden campground Arches](#)

The Devils Garden Campground is located eighteen miles from the park entrance and is open year-round. Facilities include potable water, picnic tables, grills, as well as both pit-style and flush toilets. There are no showers. Bring your own wood or charcoal for the grills. Some sites will accommodate RV's up to 30 feet in length. Telephone and on-line reservations for both group and individual sites may be made through www.recreation.gov. Reservations are not accepted by the park, and the park does not maintain information about site availability.

Individual Sites

The campground has 52 individual sites which are \$15 per night and will accommodate up to ten people. Up to 28 of the individual sites may be reserved for nights between March 1st and October 31st. Reservations must be made no less than 4 days and no more than 240 days in advance. There is an additional \$9 booking fee for reservations. To make a reservation, visit www.recreation.gov, or call (877) 444-6777, (877) 833-6777 (TDD), or (518) 885-3639.

The remaining 24 campsites are available on a first-come, first-served basis each day beginning at 7:30 a.m. at the park entrance station or visitor center.

[Morefield campground Mesa Verde](#)

To fully experience Mesa Verde's unspoiled beauty, spend a few nights at Morefield Campground. This is comfortable camping in a glorious canyon setting, just 4 miles from the park entrance. Start your day with an all-you-can-eat pancake breakfast during the summer

season at Knife's Edge Café in Morefield's full-service village. Get information regarding half-day NPS-ranger guided bus tours or the park's scenic hiking trails departing from the campground.

Browse the gift shop, or get last-minute supplies at the well-stocked grocery and camp store. Prepare an outdoor feast using your site's barbecue grill. And as you turn in for the night, with dazzling stars overhead, you'll get a true sense of Mesa Verde's wonder and peacefulness. The 435 sites are located amid native oaks and wild flowers in a spectacular wooded canyon that is popular with deer and wild turkeys. This beautiful setting is close to everything you'll need for an enjoyable camping experience. Single and Group Camping Sites

[Grand Canyon Trailer Village et Désert View](#)

Mather Campground is operated by the National Park Service and located in Grand Canyon Village, this campground offers tent and **RV** camping (no hook-ups). Reservations are required from April through November. Make **Online Reservations**, or call Biospherics at: 800-365-2267; outside the U.S. call: 301-722-1257. A maximum of two vehicles and six people are allowed per site. Sites may be reserved up to five months in advance. Mather Campground is handled on a first-come, first-served basis from approximately 01 Dec to 01 Mar of each year. Group sites are also available.

Adjacent to Mather Campground, Trailer Village offers RV sites with hook-ups. **Reservations** may be made by calling: 303-297-2757. Cost: \$1.75 for each additional person over age 16. A dump station is located adjacent to Mather Campground and Trailer Village on the South Rim (closed during the winter months).

Desert View Campground (26 miles east of **Grand Canyon** Village; no hook-ups) is open mid-May through mid-Oct and operates on a first-come, first-served basis only. Cost: \$10.00 per site (maximum of two vehicles and six people per site).
